3. THE RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT:

Rights of data subject belonging to the legal basis and their explanations

Right to information

The data subject shall have the right to be informed about the means and the purposes of processing of personal data before it occurs.

Right to rectification

The data subject shall have right to have personal data concerning their rectified, if the personal data stored by the data controller incorrect is.

Right of access

The data subject shall have right to obtain their stored personal data from the controller.

Right to erasure ('right to be forgotten')

The data subject has the right to request the permanent deletion of his / her data, unless the data processing is based on the performance of a contract, the fulfillment of a legal obligation or a public authority license.

Withdrawal of consent

The data subject shall have the right to withdraw his or her consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. Prior to giving consent, the data subject shall be informed thereof. It shall be as easy to withdraw as to give consent.

Right to restriction of processing

If the data subject does not consider the controller authorized, they can request the suspension of data processing during the investigation.

Right to data portability

The data subject shall have right to request their personal data stored in digital tabular form.

4. EXERCISE OF AFFECTED RIGHTS

If the data subject has submitted a request to the data controller related to exercising of his/her rights described in point 3, the data controller shall respond without undue delay, but no later than one month from getting the receipt of the request, and also shall inform the data subject regarding the measures taken in case of his/her request. If necessary, this deadline can be extended by another two months.

If the data controller does not take measures regarding the request of the data subject, he/she shall inform the data subject - without delay but at least within one month from getting the receipt of the request- about the reasons of the failure of taking actions and so as about the possibility of filing a complaint at the supervisory authority and exercise his/her right to judicial redress.

5. FILING A COMPLAINT

The data subject shall have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.:

6. JUDICIAL REMEDY

Provisions for the judicial remedy are included in the Act CXII of 2011 on the Right of Informational Self- Determination and on Freedom of Information.

The data subject may apply to the court against the data controller in order to protect his/her data if he/she thinks that the data controller has violated the regulations of handling his/her personal data. The lawsuit may be initiated by the data subject at the competent court based on his/her residence or temporary residence– according to his/her choice. During the lawsuit a person who does not have any legal capacity can be a party concerned as well. The data protection authority can intervene in the lawsuit in order to win the case for the person concerned.

Any person who has suffered material or non-material damage as a result of an infringement of this Regulation shall have the right to receive compensation from the controller or processor for the damage suffered. A controller or processor shall be exempt from liability if it proves that it is not in any way responsible for the event giving rise to the damage.
